Egg Shoot Rules

1. Front **Rests** or Bi-pods and Rear Bags are allowed (no one piece rests)
2. Any safe **trigger, stock, bolt or receiver** is allowed. We are essentially shooting barrels against barrels, see classes below.
3. **Semi autos** must have **brass catchers** or deflectors and all shoot in **factory class**.
4. **100 yard** shooting may be done with any sight or a scope set to a maximum of **9X** and any caliber from **.17 to .223**
5. **200 & 300 yard** shooting may be done with any sight or scope and any caliber from **.17 to .30**

Barrel Classes

Note: Factory & Super stock barrels must have visible factory markings

100 yards only

1. Factory .22 RF - .22 Cal. rimfire only. Muzzle Diameter less than .710"

100, 200 & 300 yards

2. Factory – Muzzle dia. less than .710"
3. Super stock – Muzzle dia. above .710"
4. Custom – Any unmarked barrel

The course of fire is simple

You have 5 minutes to shoot 5 eggs with 10 bullets in each of 3 rounds of fire

Time for sighting shots at paper targets before shooting eggs will be available
