Safety: All Club rules apply, incl. Eye and Ear protection. Visible **Chamber flags** will be in guns **at all times**, except when on the bench.

(Intermittent Light duties from 7:30 to about 1:30)
Sign up early (see schedule)

Egg Shoot Rules

1. Front **Rests** or Bi-pods and Rear Bags are allowed (no one piece rests)
2. **Any safe trigger, stock, bolt ,receiver and scope** is allowed. We are essentially shooting barrels against barrels, see classes below.
3. **Semi autos** must have **brass catchers or deflectors**
4. **100 yard** shooters using **iron sights** may spray paint your eggs with your own paint.

Classes

100 yards – .223 Max

1. Iron Sights - Any Rifle
2. Factory .22 LR - .22 LR only.
Muzzle Diameter less than .710”
3. Factory - Muzzle dia. Less than .710”
4. Super Stock – Muzzle dia. Above .710”

200 & 300 yards - .308 Max

1. Factory – Muzzle dia. less than .710”
2. Super stock – Muzzle dia. above .710”
3. Custom – Any unmarked barrel

The course of fire

15 minute sight-in period w/unlimited shots, 1-2 min. to setup for eggs then
10 minutes to shoot 10 eggs with 15 rounds.
